Summary of the Lecture/Activity:

HK College of Pharmacy organized the Zonal Round of 19th Avishkar: Inter-collegiate/Institute/Department Research Convention in collaboration with University of Mumbai Department of Student's Development on 12th December 2024. The occasion was graced by Dr. Waseem Javed Khan, General Secretary of Maharashtra Educational Society, Dr. Meenakshi Gurav, Officer on Duty, Dr. Tabassum Khan, Zonal Aavishkar Coordinator, Dr. Pradnya Korlekar, Zonal Aaviskar Co-cordinator and Dr. Murina Momem, Principal of BNCP. 734 Students from Pharmacy Colleges under University of Mumbai participated in the competition and 270 projects were submitted under various categories such as Medicine and Pharmacy, Humanities, Commerce and Management, Agriculture and Animal Husbandry and Engineering and Technology. The 19th Aavishkar Research Convention provided a platform to promote research culture and foster innovation across diverse fields. The projects were categorized into:

- 1) Humanities, Languages, and Fine Arts – 25 projects submitted, 2 selected
- 2) Commerce, Management, and Law – 06 projects submitted, 1 selected
- 3) Pure Sciences – 55 projects submitted, 5 selected
- 4)Agriculture and Animal Husbandry – 22 projects submitted, 3 selected
- 5) Engineering and Technology – 13 projects submitted, 5 selected
- 6) Medicine and Pharmacy – 149 projects submitted, 22 selected

Projects Selected for Final Round were 38 . A total of 83 students from Humanities, Languages, and Fine Arts participated, with 10 students selected for the final round. From Commerce, Management, and Law, 13 students participated, and 3 were selected for the final round. In the Pure Science category, 190 students participated, and 12 were selected. From Agriculture and Animal Husbandry, 65 students participated, and 3 were selected for the final round. In the Engineering and Technology category, 28 students participated, and 5 were selected. Lastly, 149 students participated in Medicine and Pharmacy, with 22 students selected from this category. The convention successfully showcased innovation, interdisciplinary research, and societal impact,

driving academic and professional growth. The students enthusiastically participated in this competition and showcased their talents through poster and oral presentations. The event concluded by giving final round certificates to the students.
