Day 1-Formals Day:

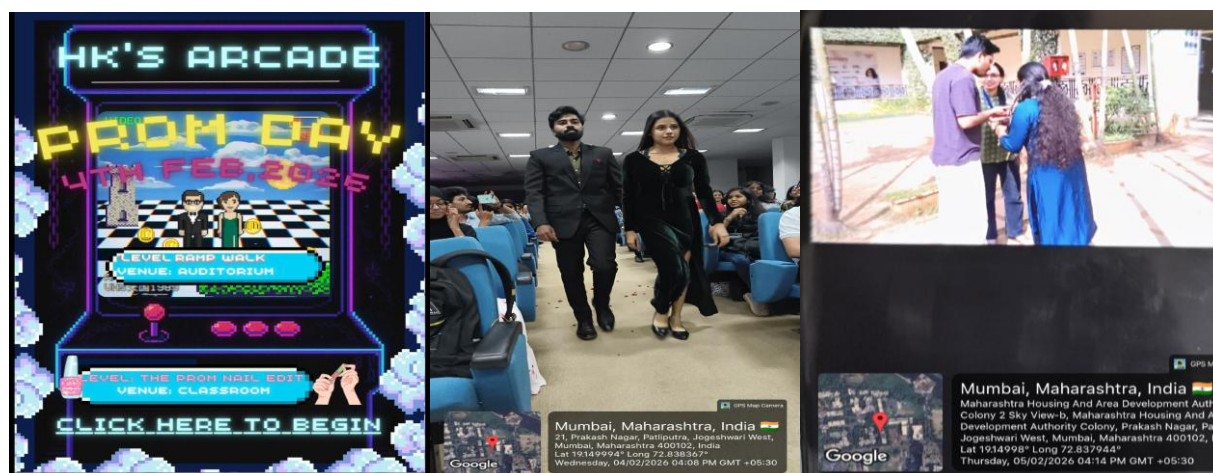

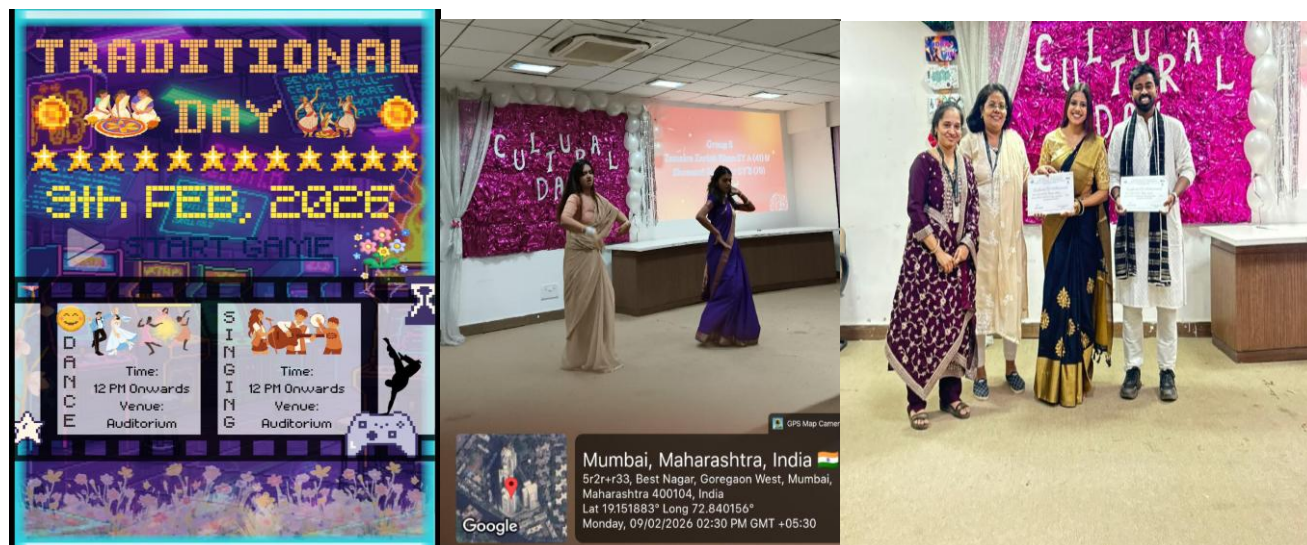
