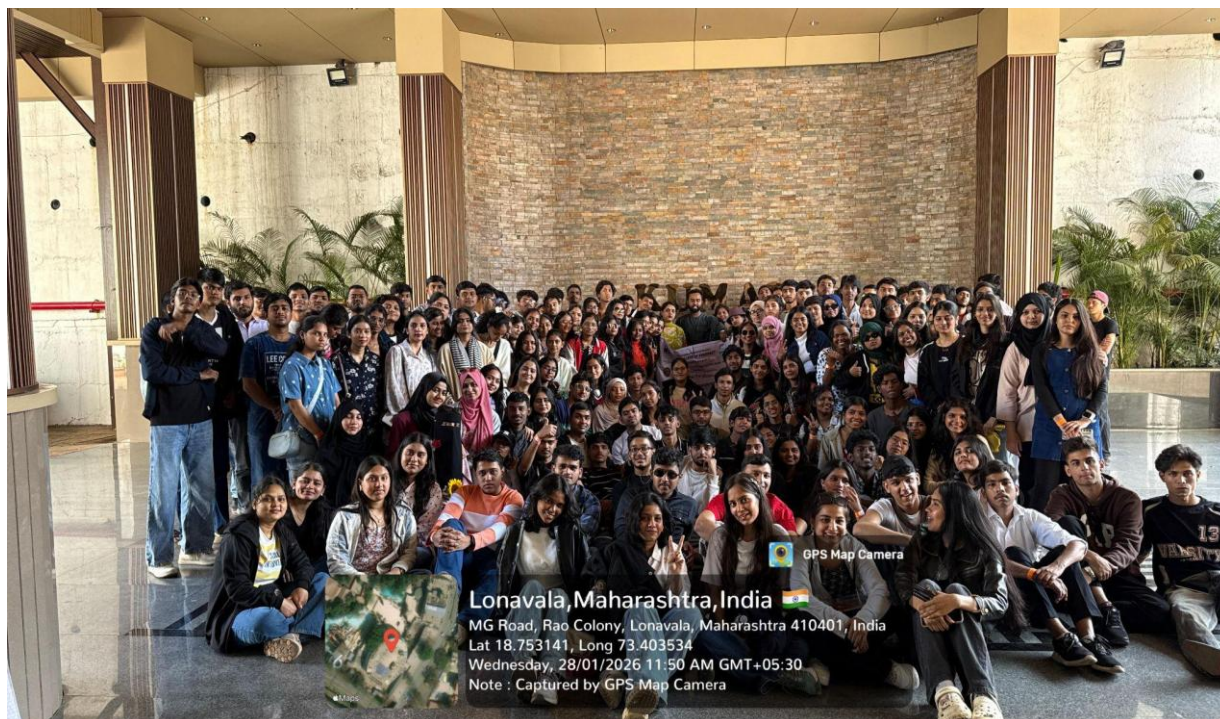
Day-wise Itinerary Overview

- **Day 1: Connection & Celebration**
