General Rules

A group can participate in more than one event. Kindly mention the same on registration form.

QUIZ Competition

1. Strictly 4 students per group are allowed.
2. There would be 4 rounds:
 - a. Picture identification
 - b. Pharmacy curriculum
 - c. General Knowledge Awareness
 - d. General science
3. 5 Questions would be asked in first THREE rounds to each team.
4. General science round would be BUZZER round: solve as many questions you can, within 1 minute time.
5. Questions would be from Pharmacy curriculum, General science & general awareness.
6. 40 Seconds to answer each question
7. 1 Marks for each question.
8. NO PASSING of questions.

DEBATE Competition

1. 3-4 students per group allowed.
2. There will be two- three** rounds before final debate.
3. Participating groups have to report before 15 minutes along with the names of their group members.
4. Topic for debate will be announced in auditorium before 5 minutes.
5. 10 minutes of preparation time will be allotted to participating group for discussion amongst themselves.
6. During debate, each group needs to allow the opponent group to complete their talk/view point before they debate. MARKS WILL BE DEDUCTED DURING EVALUATION, IF INDISCIPLINARY BEHAVIOUR IS OBSERVED.
7. One member of the each group will conclude the debate.
8. Total time for debate of each topic is 20 minutes.

Rules and time frame for final debate round will be announced after preliminary rounds.

**** Number of rounds will be depending on number of groups for debate.**

It will be announced at the start of debate competition.

MODEL making

1. Not more than 4 students per group
2. Models related to pharmacy, medicines or general science are allowed.
3. Models should be ready and located on place by 10.00 am.
4. Availability of infrastructure is limited hence it can be provided on first cum first serve basis.

Oral Presentation

1. Not more than 4 students per group
2. It has to be Power Point Presentation.
3. Presentation should be related to topics given.
4. Outside participants should report topic name by 10.00 am to respective committee.
5. Time allotted- 10 minutes for presentation + 5 minutes questions and answers.
6. In house students should submit presentation topic by 23rd September 2014

Pharma Treasure Hunt

1. The group should strictly consist of 4 members.
2. Do not open and view the clues prior to the announcement that the hunt has started.
3. The team should find all the hints in the given time limit.
4. Teams must travel on foot.
5. Teams should avoid the use of smart phones or mobile internet devices.
6. If it is discovered that cheating has taken place, the team shall be disqualified.
7. Teams must be at the same clue site at the same time. You may not split up to “divide” tasks.
8. Final decision will be taken by faculties regarding winner.

Innovative Product Packaging

1. Not more than 4 students per group
2. Packaging of Pharmaceutical products (Drugs, Cosmetics and Medicinal devices) only.
3. Packaged products should be ready and placed at allotted table by 10.00 am
4. Students should explain Scientific Strategy for marketing of the packaged product during evaluation.
