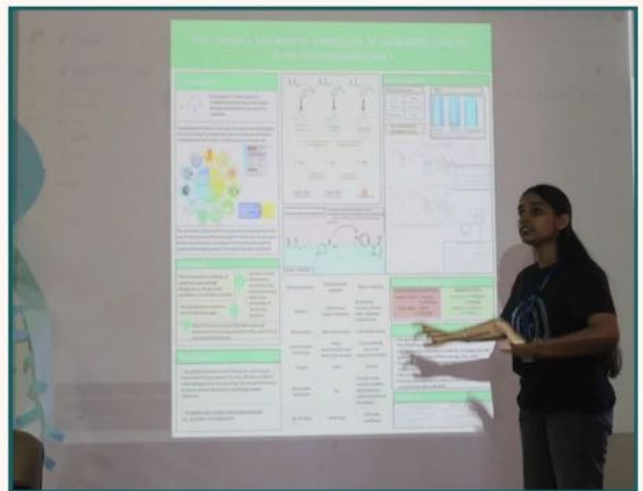

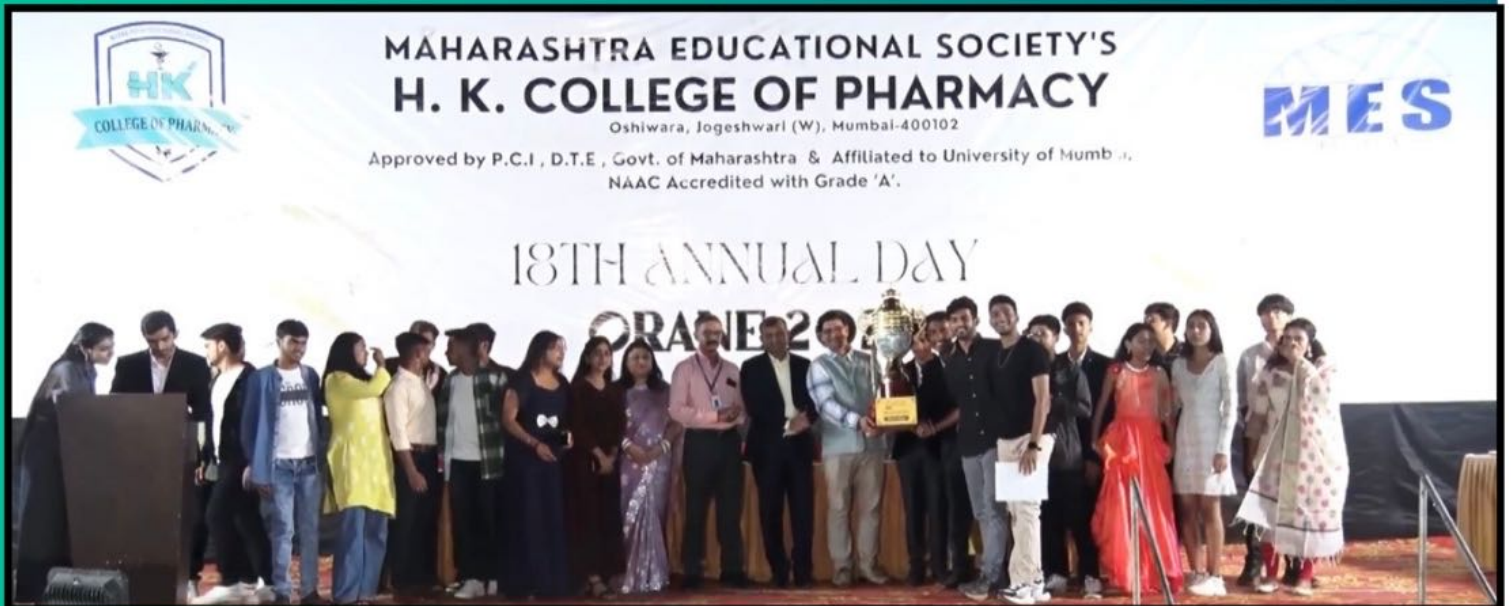

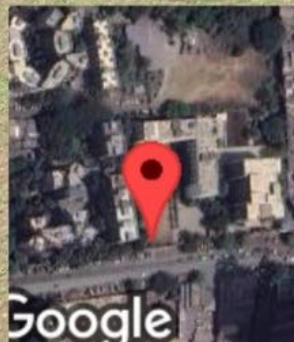
## Purpose of the Drive

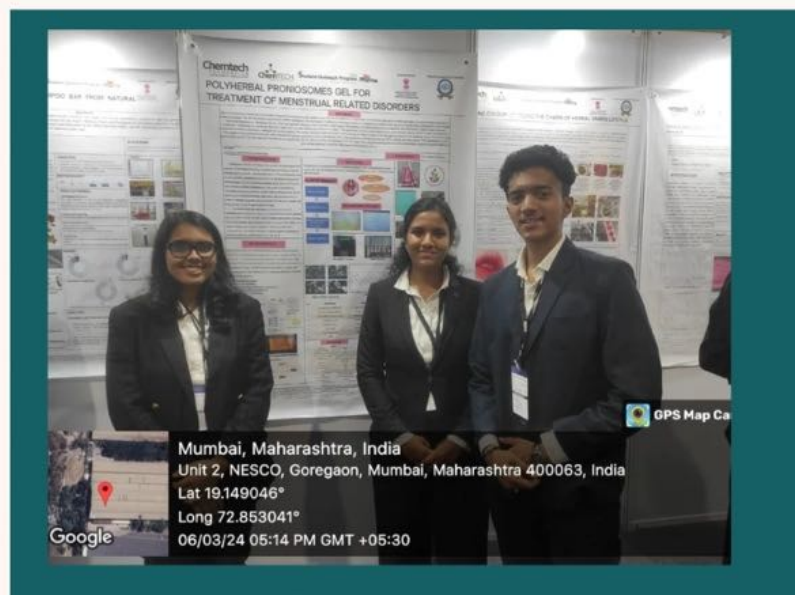

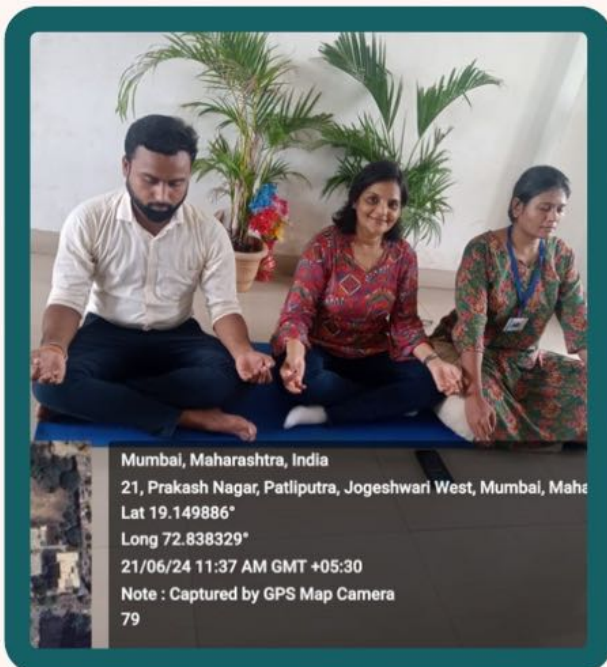


# YOGA DAY
