- The excursion inspired students to pursue healthier eating habits and regular exercise routines.



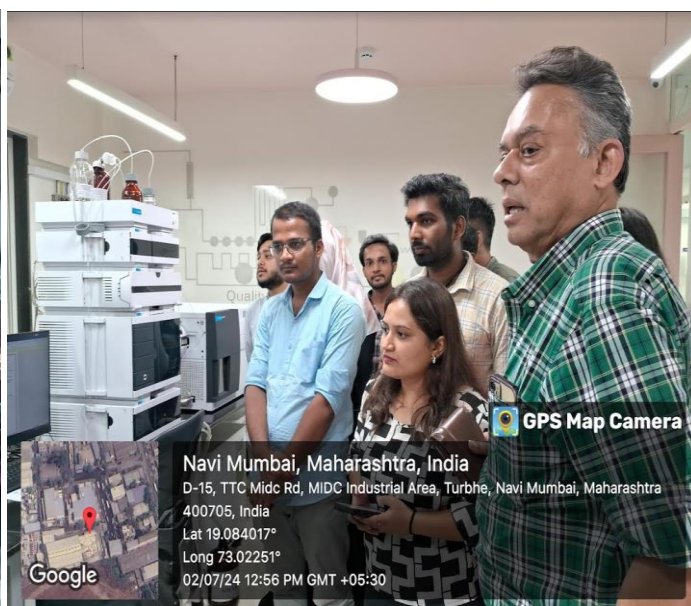
