

Summary of the Lecture/Activity:

World Pharmacist Day is celebrated every year on September 25 to recognize and appreciate the significant role of pharmacists in improving global health. This year, Extension and Outreach Committee and Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE) in collaboration with Lions Club of HK College organized a Public Awareness Program on Pharmacist Day 2025 to highlight the contributions of pharmacists and to promote awareness among the public and students about the importance of safe and effective medication use.

The students of S.Y. B. Pharm, T.Y. B. Pharm and Final year B. Pharm actively participated in the awareness program which was conducted in area nearby college premises. The students talked on various topics, some of which include: Signs and symptoms of rabies in humans and animals, Asthma-causes, the Importance of Vaccination, Routine immunization schedule for children and adults, Misconceptions and myths about vaccines, Importance of personal hygiene and handwashing, Nutrition and preventive health check-ups, Lifestyle diseases (diabetes, hypertension) and their management, Mental health and stress management and General Healthcare; with the aim of educating the community about preventable diseases and promoting proactive health practices. With increasing health challenges and misinformation, such initiatives play a vital role in strengthening public health literacy.




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Key Outcome of the Lecture/Activity:
