**Summary of the activity**

On 1st February 2025 (Saturday), Humera Khan College of Pharmacy, in collaboration with the Department of Life Long Learning and Extension and Extension and outreach committee, organizes a workshop on amendments in following acts:

- 1) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (2023) which replaces India Penal Code (IPC), 1860.
- 2) Indian citizen security act (2023) /Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) which replaces Code of Criminal Procedure (CRPC), 1973.
- 3) Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam (BSA), 2023 which replaces Indian Evidence Act (IEA), 1872.

The Supreme Court Advocate Shri Mahesh Vaswani's speech, which was the event's high point, gave important information on modern unlawful definitions, harsher punishments, quicker trial processes, and the use of technology.

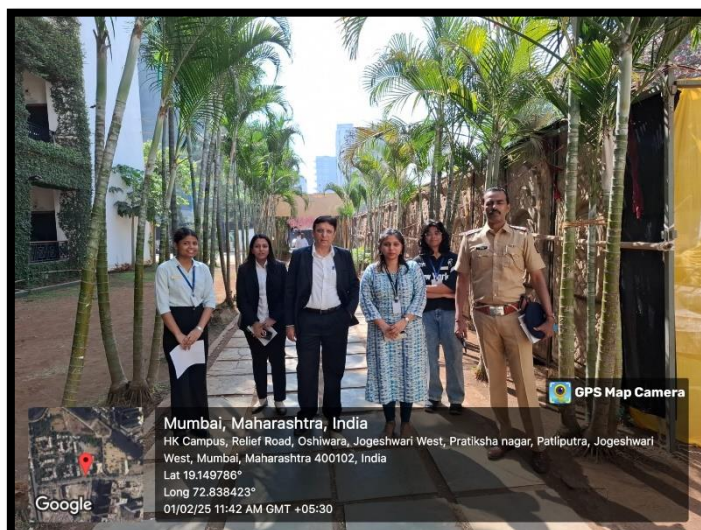
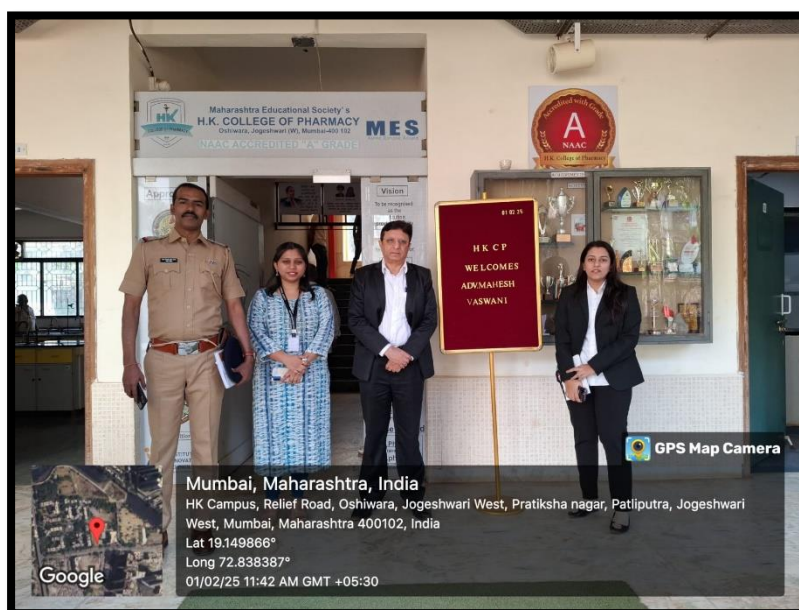
Benefits of these new laws are

- Better use of technology in which digital records, online FIRs and forensic investigation mandated
- Protection of citizen's rights- Stronger laws for women, children and victim of violence
- Lesser burden on jails - Community service as alternative for minor crimes

The speech captured audience's attention and sparked important discussion about laws mark a historic transformation in India's criminal justice system. With these laws bring faster trial, stricter punishment and improved justice mechanism and effective implementation will determine their success. Students actively attended workshop. 
Vision: To be recognized as the institution providing quality education in pharmacy to serve the healthcare sector.


