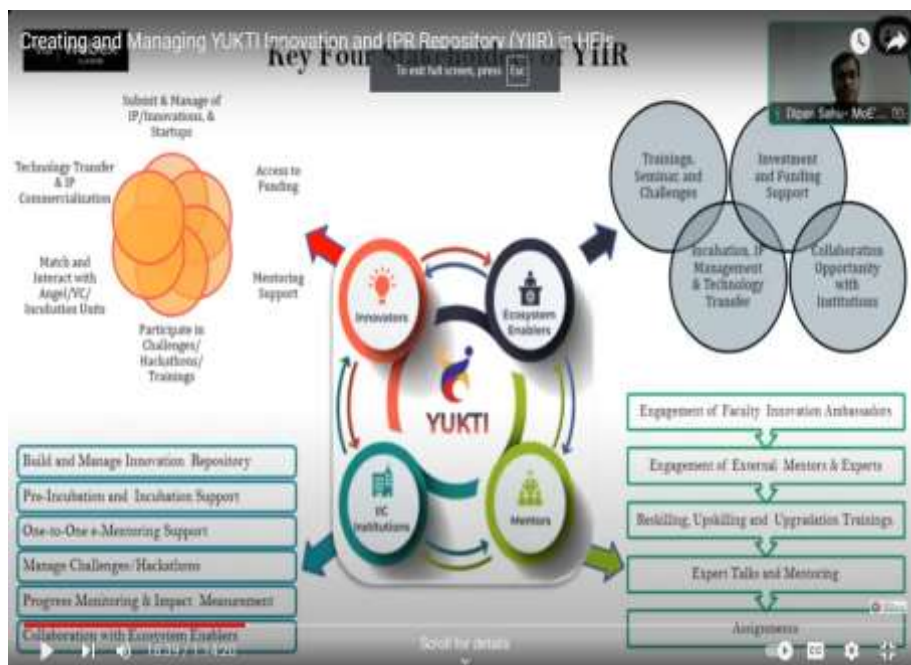
Summary of the Lecture/Activity:

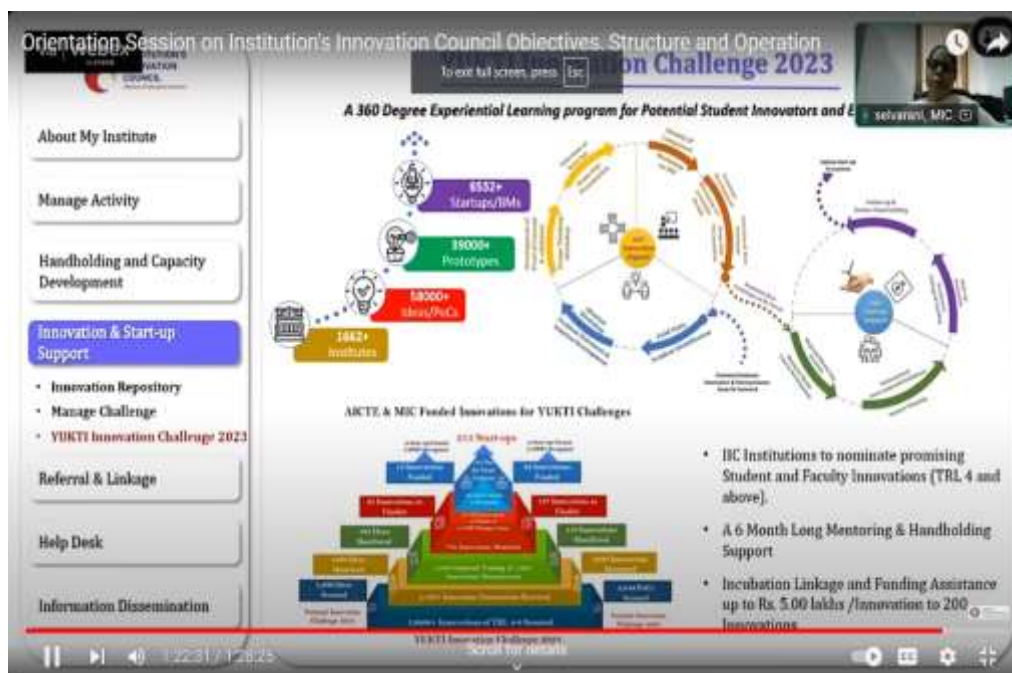
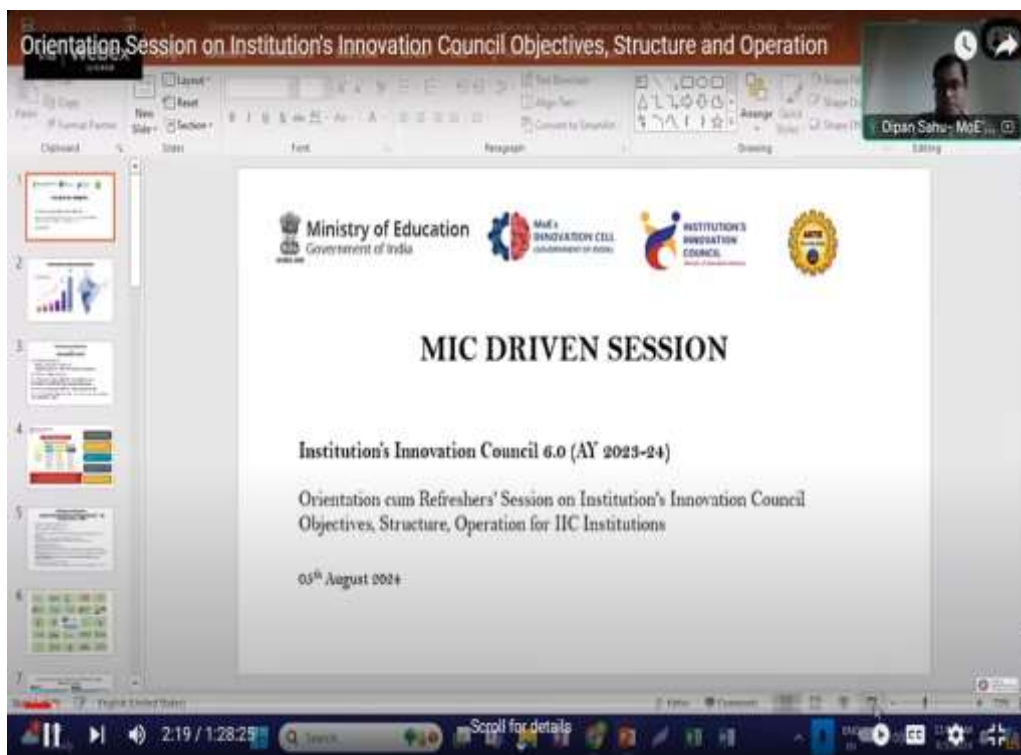
