

Summary of the Lecture/Activity:


MES's H. K. College of Pharmacy had organized a Menstrual Hygiene Awareness and Women's Empowerment Programme in collaboration with Sutantra Narayani Seva Trust, Lions Club of Powai and Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE) on 17th August 2025, Sunday at Yadav Nagar, Jogeshwari (W).

Menstruation, although a natural biological process, continues to be surrounded by stigma and misinformation in many communities. This initiative focused on breaking taboos, promoting healthy practices, and creating a supportive environment where menstruation can be discussed openly and respectfully. The program focused on creating awareness through community-based sessions conducted in slums, rural villages, and underserved urban areas. Various methods were used during the campaign, including interactive and educational sessions with young girls and women, and the use of visual aids such as posters and flipcharts. Hygiene kits containing sanitary pads were distributed to participants.

Key Outcome of the Lecture/Activity:

- By organizing and conducting awareness sessions, distributing hygiene kits, and engaging in discussions around menstrual health, the students developed a deeper understanding of the social, cultural, and health-related challenges faced by underprivileged women and girls.
- Students learned how to communicate effectively, and use inclusive language that respects different backgrounds and beliefs.
