RULES AND REGULATIONS

OF

"H.K.C.P. ALUMNI WELFARE ASSOCIATION"

C/o The Secretary

1. DEFINITIONS :

In these Rules and Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:

- a) SOCIETY : Means the "EKTA WELFARE ASSOCIATION"
- b) MEMBERS : Means the members of the society for the time being.
- c) OFFICE BEARERS : Means the President, Vice President, Secretary, Jt. Secretary, Treasurer, and those respective office bearers of the Society for the time being.
- d) ANNUAL/SPECIAL GENERAL MEETINGS : Means such General Meetings of the Society which are held under Rules and Regulations of the Society.
- e) MEETINGS : Means all meetings including Annual Meeting as well as General Body Meeting and Managing Committee of the Society.
- f) RESOLUTIONS : Means a Resolution of the Society passed in the General Body or Managing Committee Meeting by its 2/3 rd majority.
- g) SEAL : Means the common seal of the Society.

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h) **YEAR** : Means official year of the society, which begins from the 1st day of April of the said year and ends on the 31st day of March of the next year.

i) **ASSETS** : Means all the moveable and immovable property of the association excluding the present office premises where the society activities are carried out for the time being.

j) **MANAGING COMMITTEE** : Means the governing body of the Society.

2. **JURISDICTION** :

The Society shall work and promote the programmes at and around the districts of Mumbai and Maharashtra as well as all over India.

3. **ACCOUNTING / FINANCIAL YEAR** :

The Accounting/Financial year shall mean a period of 12 months beginning from the 1st day of April of the said year and ending on the 31st day of March of the next year.

4. **MEMBERSHIP & MODE OF ACCOUNTING** :

Any student / ex-student/staff of H. K. College of Pharmacy having the age of 18 years, accepts and agrees to the Rules and Regulations and Bye/laws of the society shall be eligible to become an ordinary member of the Society on payment of their subscriptions along with admission fee of Rs. 50/-, as hereinafter provided. The members shall consist of Ordinary Members, Life Members & Patron Members.

The mode of acquiring membership of the Society shall be as under:

a) Any person desirous of becoming a member of the Society shall make an application to the Society. The admission of new members shall be subject to the approval of the Committee of Management.

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- b) The Committee of management have the power to entertain and / or reject the application for membership at its absolute discretion without assigning any reason.
- c) Any person desiring to get membership of the Society shall pay an entrance fee of Rs. 50/- besides the membership fees as stipulated hereinafter.

5. TYPES OF MEMBERS :

a) ORDINARY MEMBERS :

These members as aforesaid who shall pay any yearly subscription of Rs. 100/- shall be admitted as an ordinary member of the Society subject to the approval of Committee of Management.

b) LIFE MEMBERS :

Any member who are being admitted to the society can become life member of the society by paying a single amount of Rs. 1,000/-.

c) PATRON MEMBER :

Any person paying to the Society a single amount of Rs.1,000/- or more desiring to be patronize the Society, shall be called as Patron Member of the Society, who will not have the right to participate the meetings of the Society, nor can vote in the elections.

6. CESSATION/DISCONTINUATION OF MEMBERSHIP :

- a) In the following circumstances, the member may cease to be a member of the Society.
 - (a) Resignation from the membership and its acceptance.
 - (b) Death.
 - (c) Expulsion.
 - (d) On default of payment of subscription.
 - (e) Becomes insolvent and/or bankrupt.

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- (f) Becomes insane, unsound mind, or otherwise become incapable to act.
 - (g) Convicted by any court of law for an offence involving moral turpitude.
 - (h) Non attendance or Meetings.
- b) On gross misbehaviour or negligence in working against the interest of the society the members, whoever he may be and/or as the case may be, cease to be a member of the society, if a resolution of No Confidence is passed;
- (a) at a meeting of Committee, AND;
 - (b) by the 2/3 members of the managing committee.
- c) Members expelled from or for the reasons mentioned in the above clauses shall be eligible for re-admission only after a period of five years from the date of such cessation of membership and his application shall be treated as fresh application for membership.

7. **GENERAL BODY MEETING : POWER & FUNCTIONS :**

- a) The General Body shall be the supreme authority of society in all its activities. A general Body Meeting of the Society shall be held at east once a year, within 90 days of the closing of the previous financial year to transact the following business.
- 1) to confirm minute with or without amendment of the last meeting of the General Body.
 - 2) to approve with or without amendment the annual reports, the annual balance sheet and income expenditure account.
 - 3) to elect the Managing Committee of the Society
 - 4) to look after and check the activities of the Society.
 - 5) to consider anything necessary for the purpose of attainment of the society's objects.

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- 6) to transact such other business as may be brought forward with the permission of the hair.
 - 7) amendment and/or additions to the memorandum or society and bye/law of the society.
 - 8) collaboration or amalgamation of the society with any other society or trust pursuing similar objects.
 - 9) to appoint auditors and to fix their professional charges.
 - 10) dissolution of the society and disposal of funds upon dissolution.
- b) A member can move any resolution before the General Body Meeting subject to the notice be given 15 days before to Managing Committee and seconded by the another member, but its resolution should not relate to the expulsion of a member or alteration of the Memorandum of Society.
 - c) No steps shall be taken for the cancellation of any previous resolutions of the General Body, before the expiry of 6 (six) months from the date of resolution passed.
 - d) All the matters under consideration shall be decided by the majority of votes, of the members present in the meeting, by raising their hands, if the equal numbers of votes are casted in favour and/or against the matter, then it shall be decided by the President by casting his vote.
 - e) At meeting the resolution carried out shall be noted down in a book of proceedings.
 - f) A member who is in arrears of the subscriptions of the previous year (for more than one year from the date of meeting) shall not be entitled to present his vote.
 - g) If all the business on the Agenda of General Body Meeting could not be transacted on the day on which meeting is held,

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then the meeting shall be postponed to any other suitable date and in such a case, no further notice for meeting shall be required.

8. **NOTICE FOR GENERAL BODY MEETING AND ITS FORUM :**

- a) At least 15 days notice in advance shall be given in writing either by registered post or by hand delivery, to call a General Body Meeting of members.
- b) Two/Third members of the society present in the meeting of the Society shall form quorum
- c) If for want of quorum, any meeting of the society cannot proceed with, then the meeting will be adjourned to some other date as the Committee of Management may think proper. No new matter shall be considered at the adjourned meeting except those mentioned in the agenda of the said adjourned meeting and in such a case five days notice shall be deemed sufficient.

9. **SPECIAL/EMERGENCY GENERAL BODY MEETING AND ITS FUNCTIONS :**

- a) A special/Emergency general Body meeting of the society may be called at any time at the instance of president or by the decision of the majority of the Committee of management.
- b) The meeting so convened shall not transact any business other than that mentioned in the notice of the meeting.
- c) At least 10 days notice in advance shall be given in writing either by registered post or by hand delivery to call such meeting and notice of the said meeting shall also be pasted on the Notice Board of the society.
- d) Functions and procedures for the said meeting shall be carried out in accordance to the Rules and Regulations of ordinary General Body Meeting as briefed above.

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10. MANAGING COMMITTEE :

a) The Managing Committee of the society is the Governing Body of Society, all the members of the Managing Committee shall be elected in accordance to the procedures brief in the succeeding paras.

b) The Committee of the Management shall consist of :

(a)	President	1 No.
(b)	Vice President	1 No.
(c)	Secretary	1 No.
(d)	Jt. Secretary	1 No.
(e)	Treasurer	1 No.
(f)	Member	<u>6 Nos.</u>
	Total	<u>11 Nos.</u>

and/or such other members, as may be necessary, duly elected at a meeting of the society convened for the purpose in the manner hereinafter provided for.

c) The Managing Committee of the Society shall consist not less than 7 members and not more than 11 members.

11. TERMS OF MANAGING COMMITTEE :

- a) The term of Managing Committee shall be for a period of three years.
- b) The members of the Managing Committee will be elected after every three years in the General Body Meeting by a secret ballot system. The elected members shall decide amongst themselves the office bearers for the Society.

12. OFFICE BEARERS OF MANAGING COMMITTEE AND THEIR DUTIES :

The Managing committee of the Society shall consist of the following office bearers :

- a) President.
- b) Vice President
- c) Secretary.
- d) Jt. Secretary.
- e) Treasurer
- f) Member

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a) PRESIDENT :

The President shall preside over every meeting. The president shall guide and supervise activities of Society. The Ruling of the president at meeting shall be FINAL & BINDING on all questions raised.

b) VICE PRESIDENT :

The Vice President shall share the duties of the President in the working of the General course of works and shall be working in close co-ordination with him. He will preside the meeting in absence of the President.

c) SECRETARY :

The Secretary will be In-charge of the office of the Society and amongst other do the following acts and things:

1. To check and verify accounts and sign the same.
2. To sign and issue notices for the meeting of the managing committee and the annual meeting of the society and to make necessary arrangement for holding meeting of the society and shall write and keep the minutes of such meetings.
3. To look after and conduct all the correspondence relating to or in any way concerning to the society.
4. To keep or cause to be kept in proper order and custody all documents and papers and files belonging to the society.
5. To operate or cause to be operated by him on Bank Account in one or more banks or as approved by the Committee of Management in conjunction with the treasurer of the Society.
6. To sign in token of sanction all vouchers for necessary expenses within the limits sanctioned by the committee of management before payment by the treasurer.

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7. He shall be responsible for submitting to the Registrar of Society all returns and notices that should be sent under the Societies Registration Act, 1860.
8. He shall be at liberty to keep and expend any sums up to Rs.1000/ without previous sanction of Managing Committee for the purpose of Society.

d) JT. SECRETARY :

The Jt. Secretary shall share the duties of the Secretary in the working of the General course of works and shall be working in close co-ordination with him. He will look after the duties of the Secretary in his absence.

e) TREASURER :

1. To receive subscriptions, donations in cash or kind and record the same in books maintained for the purpose.
2. To arrange for investment of surplus assets of the Society as approved by the Committee in conjunction with the Gen. Secretary of the Society.
3. To operate on Bank Account in one or more banks as approved by the committee of management in conjunction with the Gen. Secretary.
4. To submit all books and papers relating to the society receipts and expenditures, account books, bank passbook etc.
5. To the Gen. Secretary of the Society once in a month for his scrutiny and signatures.
6. To prepare yearly accounts of receipts and expenditures and have the same audited by the Auditor and present the same before the Annual General Body Meeting of the Society.
7. He shall be at liberty to keep and spend any sum upto Rs.500/- without previous sanction of the Managing Committee for the purpose of Society.

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f) **MEMBER :**

1. The members of the society shall have right to one vote at General Body Meeting and Special General Body Meeting and Committee of the Society.
2. The members of he society shall be bound by the Rules and Regulations of the society, which may be framed from time to time.
3. The members shall be entitled to participate in the meeting and functions of the society.

13. **MEETING OF MANAGING COMMITTEE AND MEETING ON REQUISITION :**

1. The Committee of the Management shall meet every three months or on such day at such place as may be fixed by the society in consultation with the President.
2. In case of requisition or demands of the meeting of the Managing Committee by its members, not les than $\frac{2}{3}$ members, the meeting of the Committee of the Management will be called and carried out subject to the provisions as laid down in this regard.

14. **NOTICE FOR MEETING OF MANAGING COMMITTEE AND QUORUM :**

1. Notice may be served to the members of the Committee either personally or by sending it through registered post to their registered address.
2. At least 10 days notice shall be given for a meeting of the Managing Committee whereas for an urgent meeting 5 (five) days notice shall be sufficient.
3. $\frac{2}{3}^{\text{rd}}$ members of the committee personally present in meeting shall form quorum. However, if there are less than $\frac{2}{3}^{\text{rd}}$ committee members then it will be necessary to adjourn meeting to some other date as the committee of management may think fit and proper in the circumstances, and in such case, five day notice shall be deemed to be sufficient.

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4. The notice must indicate the place, date and hour thereof as well as the item of agenda.

15. RULES FOR ELECTION OF MANAGING COMMITTEE :

- a) All members of society elect members of Managing Committee after every three years in the General Body Meeting.
- b) If necessary, Managing Committee in existence will frame rules for election.
- c) Any member who wants to be elected on the Managing Committee should submit applications to President.
- d) If such applications fall short in number, the candidates will be declared elected unopposed. The said unopposed members will have right to increase the other members as specified in item No. 10 of these presents by co-options of members.
- e) If excess applications are received, members are to be elected by majority of votes.
- f) Elected members shall elect among themselves the office bearers of the society.
- g) The existing Managing Committee has right to choose the method/mode of election.

16. FILLING UP THE VACANT POST OF MANAGING COMMITTEE :

- a) In case of any vacancy in the post of any of the members on any account, then a new member will be co-opted by the committee of management from amongst the society members.
- b) Such a new member, appointed on vacant seat will hold office till the next election of the committee of management.

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- c) Pending filling up the vacancy the remaining members in the committee will carry on the work of the society and the properties of the society shall vest in the remaining members.

17. RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF MANAGING COMMITTEE :

The Managing Committee shall be empowered with any, every and all functions pertaining to the administration, control and management of the society and will decide on all questions and more particularly the committee of management acting collectively shall have powers to:

- a) Represent the Association/Trust
- b) Acquire/Purchase and transfer, sale, dispose property. Moveable, Immoveable or both assume obligations and conclude agreement of any nature.
- c) Appoint the personnel of the society, determine their remuneration, salaries and other service conditions and also to terminate their services dismissal or otherwise and take disciplinary action as necessary.
- d) Open and operate Bank accounts, deposits, withdraw or invest funds, issue, accept, sign, endorse and deliver cheques, drafts, letters of credit and in general any other negotiable instrument.
- e) Determine and incur expenses in general and administer the finance of the society and to raise, receive and accept funds, subscriptions, donations, offerings and money and all kind of gifts and charities.

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- f) Decide on the establishment of branch office of the Society.
- g) Exercise control over the books and funds of the society, prepare and submit to the general body meeting the annual report, the balance sheet, income and expenditure account of the society.
- h) For bye/laws relating to the internal administrations of the society.
- i) Decide on any, every matters pertaining to or in connection with the administration of the society and the successful pursuance of aims and objects.
- j) To make arrangements or appointment of the members councils, committee, such committees or such other bodies and delegate the power as may be required from time to time.
- k) To approach and make representation o Government, Semi government, Police, Municipal or local authority or authorities or any other person for attainment and/or for the fulfilment of the objects of the society.
- l) The Powers, functions and presenting not defined in the Rules & Regulations, shall vest with the committee of management.

18. SOURCE OF FUND & ITS UTILISATION :

- a) The Society can raise its funds from the following sources:
 - 1. Membership fees and subscriptions.
 - 2. Donation in the form of moveable or immoveable properties, Gifts, offerings etc.
 - 3. Grants from various Government, Government Undertakings and all possible sources.
 - 4. The funds will be utilised to attain the aims and subjects of the society.

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19. PROVISIONS FOR LOANS & DEPOSITS :

- a) The managing committee can raise loans for fulfilment of objects of the society subject to permission of the Charity Commissioner.
- b) The society can keep its funds in fixed deposit with any nationalised/ scheduled bank as may be decided by he managing committee.

20. PROVISION FOR EXPENDITURE :

- a) The funds of the society shall be used for the fulfilment of the objects of the society.
- b) After taking the permission of General body the managing committee can allot the fund for the attainment of the aims and objects of the society.

21. PURCHASE/SALE OF IMMOVEABLE PROPERTY :

The Society, subject to the permission of Charity Commissioner, can sale, mortgage, lease, transact the whole or part of the property of the society.

22. BANK ACCOUNT :

The Bank account of the society shall be opened in any nationalised / schedule Bank in the name of the society and shall be operated upon jointly by any two of the following members whereas the signature of Treasurer shall be compulsory.

- a) President.
- b) Secretary.
- c) Treasurer.

23. REGISTER OF MEMBERS :

The Register / list of persons who are members of the Society, within the meaning of the section No.15, of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, will be maintained in the form of schedule VI of the societies Registration Act (Maharashtra Rules) 1971 vide Rule No.15 thereof.

24. AMENDMENTS OF RULES AND REGULATIONS :

The Rules and Regulations shall be amended, altered replaced or added at any time by the majority of 3/5th members present in the

General body meeting providing at least 30 days previous intimation in writing of such amendment shall have been given to the members as per the provisions of the section 12 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

25. ALTERATION IN NAME AND OBJECTS :

The name and objects of the society shall be amended, altered and/or added at any time by the majority of 3/5th of the members present at the General Body meeting provided at least 30 days previous intimation in writing of such amendment of the name objects shall have been given to the members of the society, as per provisions of section 12 and 12A of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

26. DISSOLUTION :

The Society may dissolve, as decided at General Body Meeting of the Society, by members not less than 2/5th of the present at the meeting called for said purpose. The Society is bound to give at least 30 days previous notice to its members of the said intention, dissolution of the society shall be done in accordance with the section 13 and 14 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

Students were made aware of the classification of medical devices and the regulatory requirements.

Key Highlights of the Activity/Lecture:

As Mr. Shailesh Katariya entered the auditorium he was welcomed with a loud applause from the audience. He was accompanied by the Principal Dr. Tushar Lokhande and Dr. Anagha Raut. Dr.



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Archana Upadhyia delivered the introductory note. Dr. Tushar Lokhande felicitated Mr. Shailesh Katariya with a token of appreciation.

Mr. Shailesh Katariya first recounted his experiences at several organizations (on demand by the audience) and then began delving into the topic of his expertise -Medical Devices. He gave a summary of medical devices explaining the difference between a drug and a medical device. He then thoroughly explained the challenges faced by the Indian Regulatory Authority CDSCO for regulating the medical devices. He gave an overview of various regulatory agencies around the globe. He made the audience aware of the classification of medical devices and the stringency of criteria that is associated with regulatory evaluation of each class of medical devices.

He emphasized that a manufacturer of medical devices desirous of selling his device in the Indian Market, must register at the government "SUGAM" portal, and follow the directives thereof. Mr. Shailesh Katariya, then interacted one-on-one with the students clearing the doubts and queries about the topic.

It was an informative and interesting session for students and faculty who gained knowledge outside their core expertise.

Following points were discussed in the meeting.

I. Review:

Minutes of previous meeting were read. The action taken based on the previous meeting was discussed.

1. Green Initiative:

- QR code for SOP's: Created QR code for all the laboratory SOPs and training was provided to all the laboratory assistants. The initiative was aimed to reduce the usage of paper
- Beach Clean –up drive: The mass cleanup drive was planned on World Earth Day, 23rd April 2023. The drive was undertaken in association with the NGO, "Muskurate Raho" at Mahim beach
- Mango seed donation: The college organized a Mango seed collection drive on the occasion of World Environment Day on 2nd June 2023. On this day students collected the dry mango seeds and submitted to for plantation during rainy season.
- World Environment Day celebration: Celebrated World Environment Day, 5th June 2023 by planting the trees in college premises.

Dr. Munira Momin appreciated the green efforts made by the institution. She suggested installation of auto cut-off switches to reduce energy consumption. She also suggested that fixing aerators in the taps can reduce water consumption. She suggested that display of placards with environment messages can have impact on the minds of the students.

Dr. Munira also enquired regarding the academic audit. Dr. Anagha said that we have an internal audit team which performs audit at the end of each semester. 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2. Training of Non-teaching Staff:

- Two training programs were organized for non-teaching staff
- Basic Microbiology Lab Training - 4 days
 - Fire Safety Training and Lab Safety Training - 2 days

Dr. Munira suggested that these trainings should be imparted to post graduate students as well. Dr. Anagha replied that we have already conducted these training sessions separately for the M. Pharm. students. She also suggested display of signages to understand the usage of firefighting equipment in case of emergency. Principal, Dr. Saraf said that signages can be displayed at appropriate locations.

Dr. Munira also said that WRIC team voluntarily conducts workshops on Handling & Maintenance of Instrumentation. Principal, Dr. Saraf suggested to collaborate with WRIC for such workshops.

3. Alumni talk:

Dr. Anagha informed that we are planning to introduce alumni talks on monthly basis from AY 2023 – 2024. This is in addition to the mentor-mentee program.

Dr. Munira said that she appreciates your mentor-mentee program. She spoke about introduction of shadow program for select mentees. She suggested to invite alumni for Orientation & Convocation programs. Principal, Dr. Saraf asked the alumni Mr. Rushabh & Mr. Shailesh for their active involvement in alumni connect. They said that informal connects will help the students understand the industry needs.

4. Analysis of Semester VII results

Dr. Anagha informed that our student has secured third position, however, there is a large difference in CGPA of first and third position. Also no. of students reflecting in five position is only one. The following measures were implemented

- Strict monitoring of attendance in Semester VIII through class coordinator & mentors
- Monitoring the performance in assignment & quiz through subject In-charges

The alumni suggested that formation of groups of students will help in active group learning. The said that practicing together helps in better understanding and concept clearance. Principal, Dr. Saraf informed about the remedial measures initiated for students failing in the subjects.

5. Metrics for NIRF ranking

The following measures were implemented

- i. Placement committee was asked to negotiate salary with employers.
- ii. Celebration of important days in a month and uploading of photos on social media accounts.
- iii. Research publications for the AY 2022 – 2023 were 47

Dr. Munira said that negotiating salary is a difficult task. She asked to involve Alumni to train the students for corporate readiness. Dr. Saraf suggested the alumni to take active interest in such trainings. Dr. Munira suggested to publish articles in Scopus indexed or Web of Science journals.

II. Academic Plan 2023 – 2024

1. Implementation of Practice School

Dr. Anagha discussed the plan for implantation of Practice School. She informed that the practical of practice school have been planned considering multidisciplinary in nature of projects.



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2. Conduct of UHV course

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

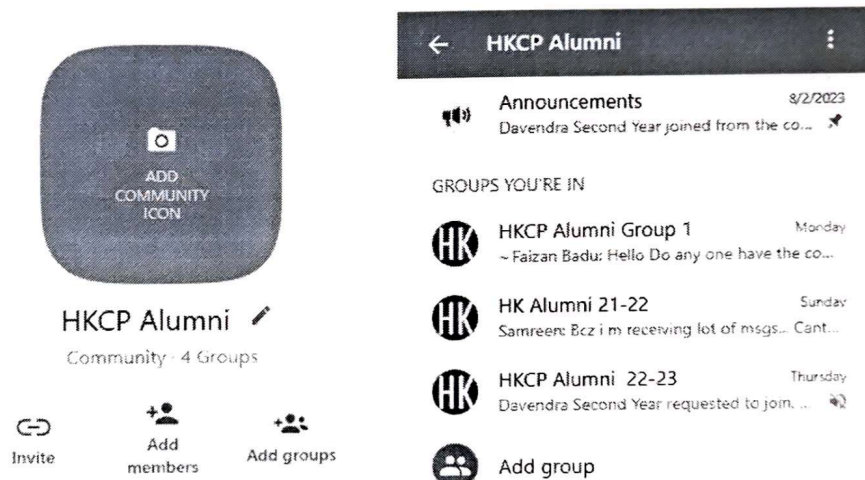
