Prior to the drive, saplings were procured. A special thanks to **Lion Monica Gada**, a well-wisher and environmental enthusiast, who generously **donated 100 saplings** for this plantation drive. These included a variety of traditional and Ayurvedic plants known for their health and ecological benefits, such as: Adulsa (*Justicia adhatoda*), Nirgundi (*Vitex negundo*), Agnimantha (*Clerodendrum phlomidis*), Insulin plant (*Costus igneus*), Kadu Karita (*Swertia chirata*), Paanphutti (*Bryophyllum pinnatum*), Hadjod (*Cissus quadrangularis*), Lasson Vel (*Allium* species), Rui (*Calotropis gigantea*), Jaswant (*Hibiscus rosa-sinensis*) and Paan (*Piper betle*).


