

Summary of the Lecture/Activity:

World Nature Conservation Day is observed every year on July 28th to raise awareness about the importance of protecting and conserving natural resources. It emphasizes sustainable living, biodiversity protection, and the need to minimize our environmental footprint for the well-being of present and future generations. The theme for 2025, "Beat Plastic Pollution", aligns with global environmental goals to combat one of the most pressing threats to our planet: plastic waste.

The Extension and Outreach Committee of MES's H. K. College of Pharmacy, organized an Awareness program on the theme "Beat Plastic Pollution" on 28th July 2025, in collaboration with Green Club, Lions Club of Powai and Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE).

As part of the awareness program on World Nature Conservation Day, the students actively interacted with members of the local community to explain the harmful effects of plastic pollution. Through simple demonstrations, charts, and one-on-one conversations, students educated residents about how plastic waste affects soil, water, marine life, and even human health. They highlighted the dangers of single-use plastics, encouraged the use of eco-friendly alternatives like cloth bags and reusable containers, and shared tips on reducing plastic consumption in daily life.


