Summary of the Lecture/Activity:

To adequately prepare B. Pharmacy students for careers in the health care sector, MITCON, Consultancy & Engineering Services Limited—an ISO 9001:2015 certified organization recognized by NSDC (National Skill Development Corporation), LSSSDC (Life Sciences Sector Skill Development Council), and DSIR (Department of Scientific & Industrial Research)—entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with H. K. College of Pharmacy, supported by the Department of Science and Technology.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) facilitated the execution of the fourth and fifth modules of the Value-Added Course titled “Poster Presentation and Mock Interview” for Second, Third, and Final Year B. Pharm students on March 15, 2025. The program aimed to enhance students' essential skills, including interpersonal communication, teamwork, verbal expression, active listening, problem-solving, and interview response techniques, all crucial for success in the pharmaceutical industry's selection process. Prior to this, students had engaged in a mock aptitude test during Module 3. As part of their ongoing training, they were assigned to develop PowerPoint presentations on topics such as creating an effective CV, delivering compelling presentations, and

writing professional emails. This was followed by a Mock Interview Session, where students encountered a range of technical and aptitude-related questions designed to assess their confidence, quick thinking, and soft skills in an interview context. Participants expressed that the program significantly contributed to their career development after earning their B. Pharmacy degree.

Key Outcome of the Lecture/Activity:

Students were made aware of essential elements designed to enhance core competencies such as verbal communication, teamwork, interpersonal skills, active listening, problem-solving ability, and interviewing techniques.

Students also worked on making PowerPoint presentations and building a strong resume. After that, a mock interview was held where students faced a variety of technical and aptitude-based questions designed to evaluate their self-assurance, ability to think quickly, and soft skills in an interview setting.
