Summary of the Activity:-

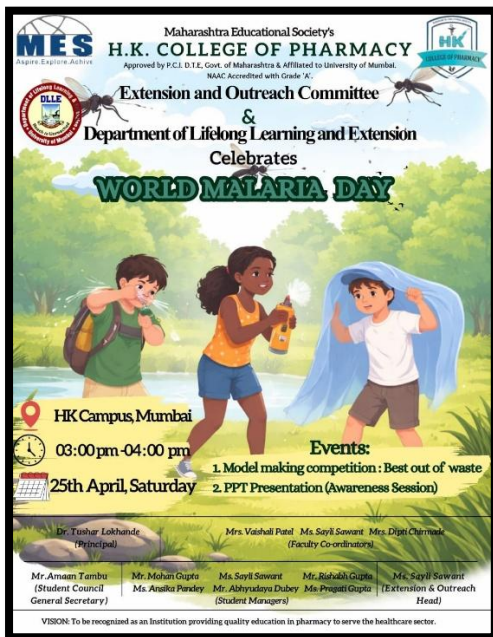
