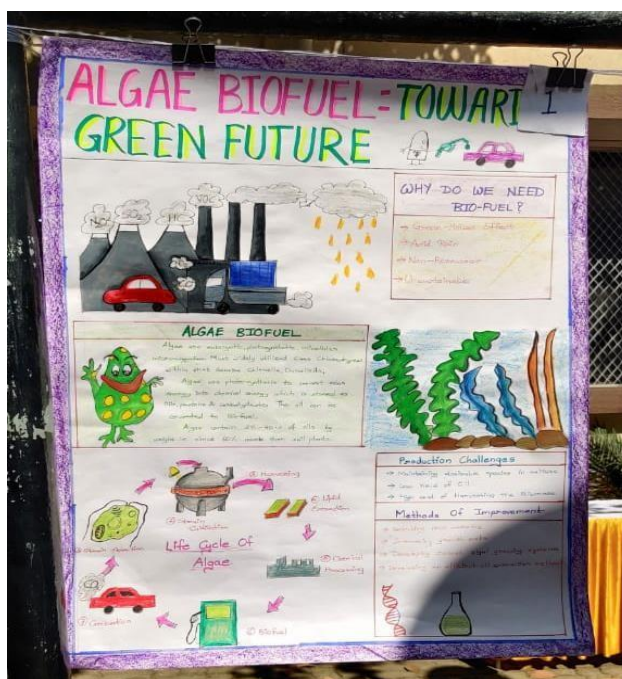

EXTRA-CIRRICULAR ACTIVITIES

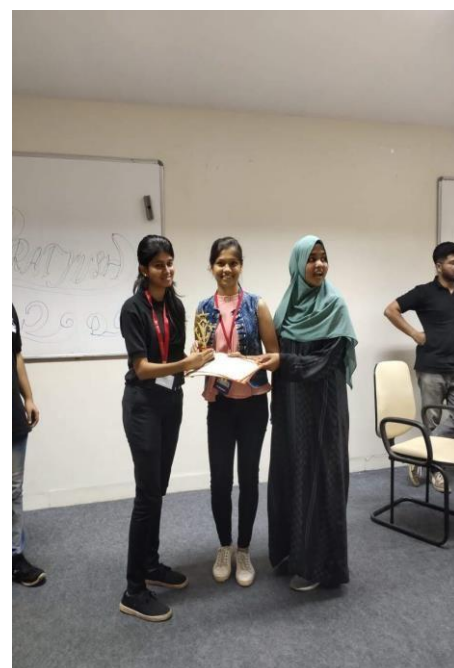
1. DALAAL STREET:

7. NATIONAL SLOGAN AND EXTEMPO COMPETITION

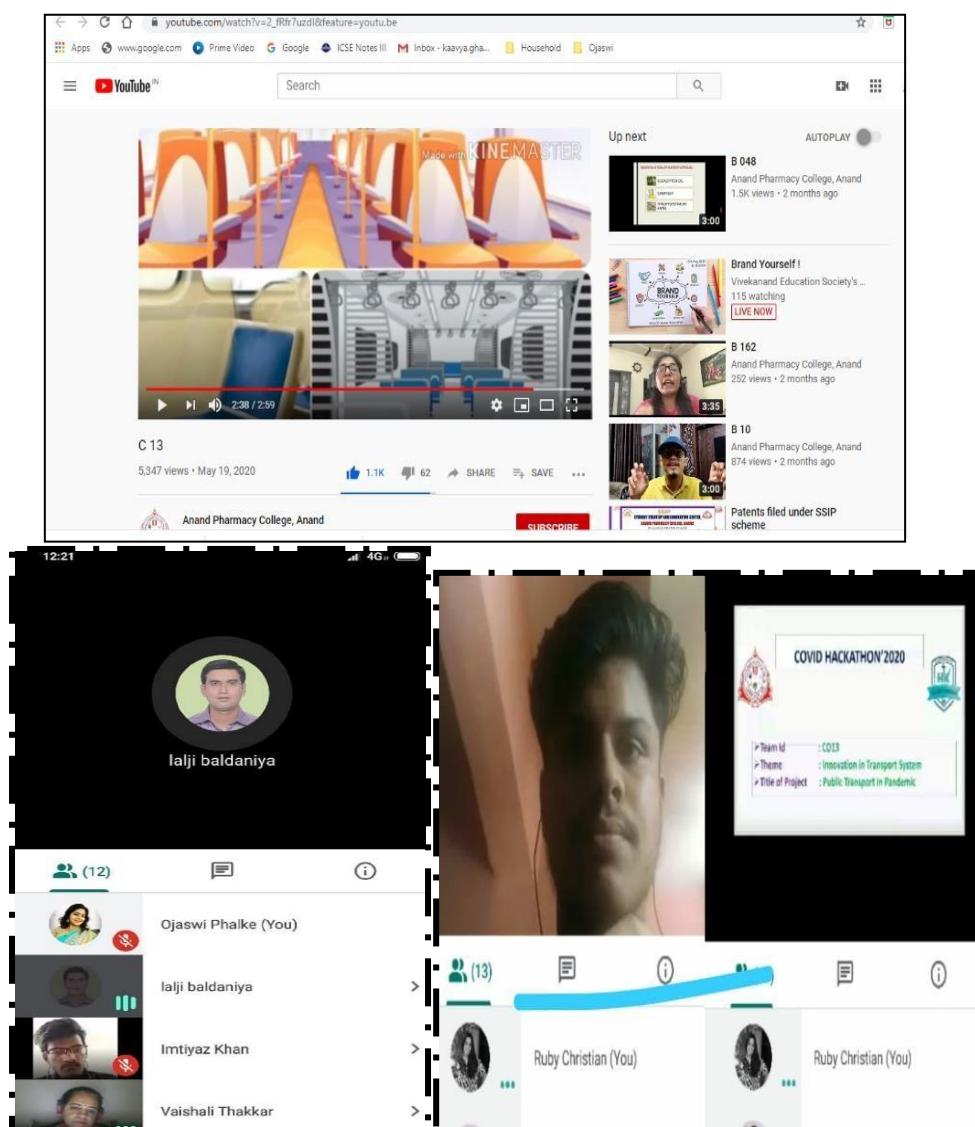
