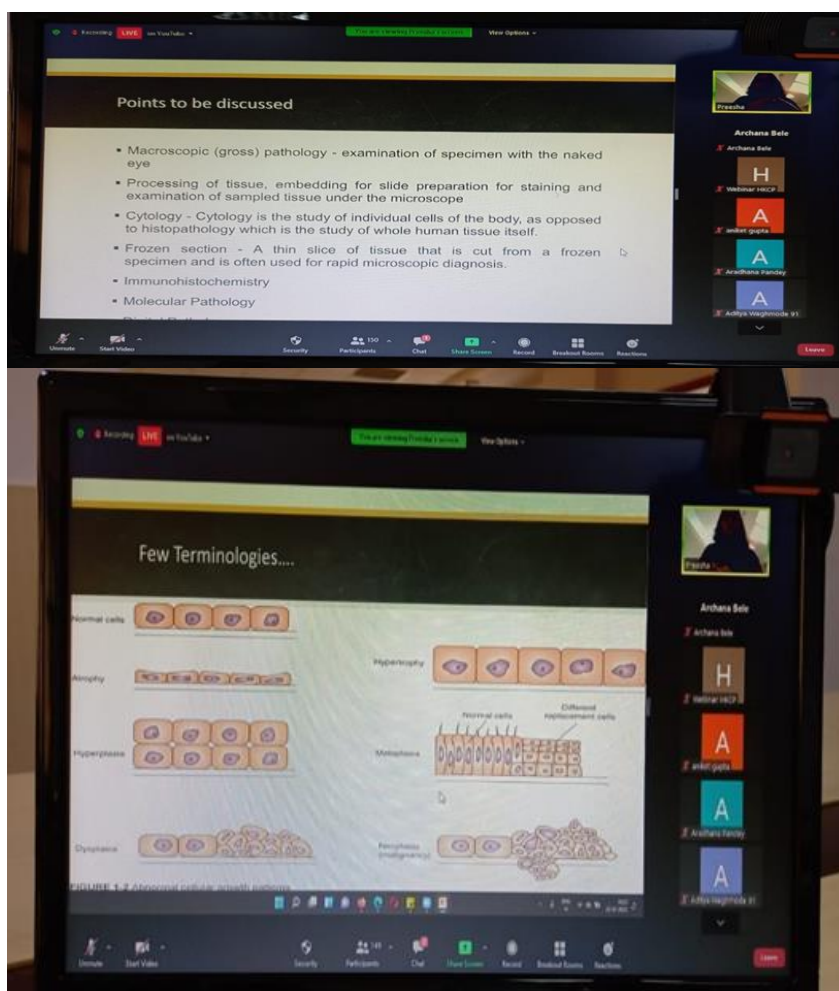
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## INSIGHTS TO HISTOPATHOLOGICAL ASPECTS

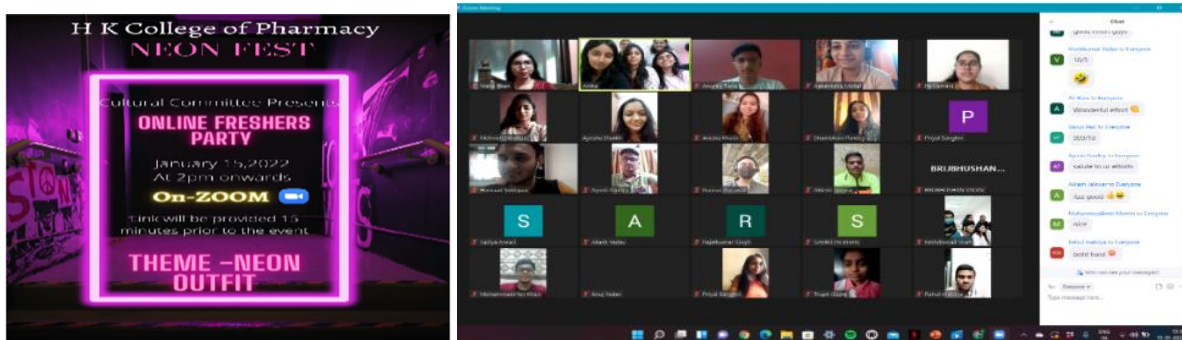
## CULTURAL DAY

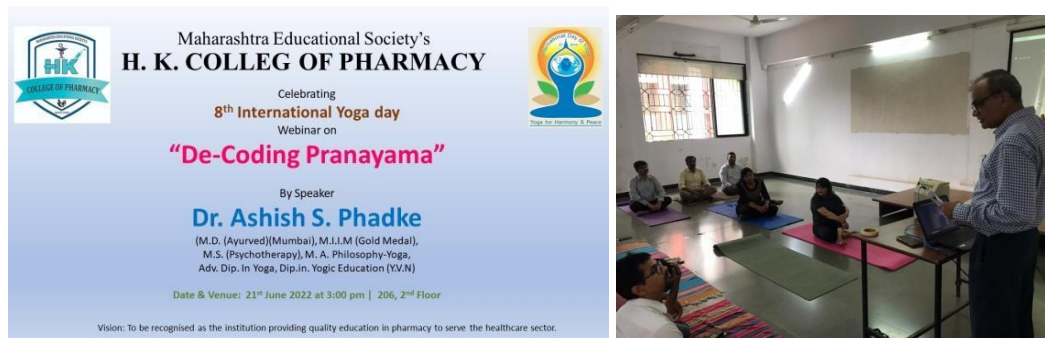


formally organized by Dr. Priyanka Goswami & Dr. Anagha Raut. The importance of Green Earth, ecosystem & environment conservation was discussed.

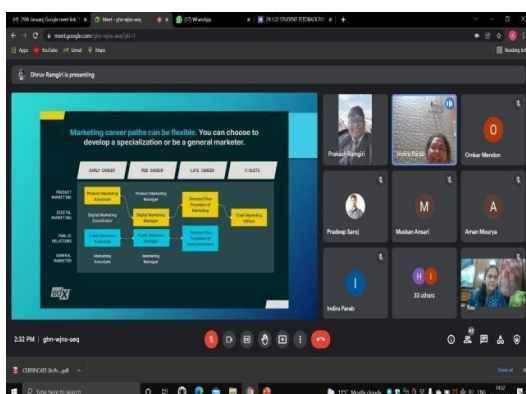




## CAREER GUIDANCE SESSION


