This has reference to your application dated 28th October, 2005 for affiliation of a new college for Pharmacy proposed to be started at Oshiwara Jogeshwari (West), from the academic year 2006-07.

In this connection, I am directed to inform you that considering the permission granted by the Director, Directorate of Technical Education, Maharashtra State on the basis of resolution passed by the Government of Maharashtra to your Society to start the Bachelor of Pharmacy degree Course for the academic year 2006-2007, the Academic Council at its meeting held on 18th August, 2006 vide item No.3.10 has granted the permission for first time affiliation to your Society to open a new college of Pharmacy imparting B.Pharm. degree course for the academic year 2006-07, on permanently 'No Grant Basis' with intake of not more than 60 students, subject to fulfillment of the terms and conditions mentioned in :-

The college has also to fulfill the following affiliation conditions -

- (1) that the conditions laid down by the University from time to time.
- (2) that the minimum attendance of all the students must not be less than 75% during the academic year and college will have to complete syllabus of all the subjects during the academic year.
- (3) Admissions should not be linked with donations.
- (4) that they will strictly follow the Ordinance 2802 in respect of preventing the colleges and Management of Colleges from accepting donation or capitation fees for admission of students in the Colleges, quoted in the University Circular No.Aff./Recog./49 of 1987, dated 4th February, 1987 (copy enclosed.)

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
