The purpose of the initiative was to make access to sanitary napkins easy and to create awareness

about women's health. Another important area that requires critical attention is that of menstrual

waste management. Hence, an incinerator has been installed to stop unsafe management of the

waste.

The sanitary napkin machine was inaugurated. During the event all instructions and training were

given to the participants on the operation of the machine and the incinerator. One student inserted

a five-rupee coin and dispensed a sanitary napkin.

Ms. Jayshree said that the implementation of these vending machine and incinerator is a significant stride towards fostering menstrual hygiene and prioritizing women's reproductive health. Menstruation is a natural, normal biological process experienced by adolescent girls and women starting from menarche to menopause; the total duration of these days of menstruation adds up to about seven years of their lives.

The talk was followed by fruitful discussion on how to maintain cleanliness and hygiene of the GIRLS common room.
