Summary of the Lecture/Activity:

Mr. Amol More introduced the concept of Pharmacovigilance and the role of Adverse Drug Reaction Reporting to students and Staff on the occasion of National Pharmacovigilance Week announced by PCI to be celebrated between 17-23 Sep 2024.

During the seminar, students were apprised of the difference between Adverse Drug Event and Adverse Drug Reaction and the different ways adverse drug reactions are identified. Speaker stressed on the fact that many of the adverse drug reactions go unnoticed due to lack of proper communication and documentation. He then mentioned how the role of Pharmacist could be useful in reporting of adverse drug reaction and what should we do as Pharmacist to circumvent any life threatening adverse reaction. Speaker also mentioned that we as Pharmacist should make public aware of perils of adverse drug reactions and inform authorities accordingly.
