Title: Induction Program for First Year B.Pharm and M.Pharm

Objective:

1. To introduce the newly inducted B.Pharm and M.Pharm Students of HK College of Pharmacy to the course and requirements to be met for successful completion of course.
2. To apprise parents of newly joined students about the various academic and non-academic (cultural/sports/annual day) events planned for students while undergoing B.Pharm course.
3. To orient Parents and Students of HK College of Pharmacy about Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Rules to be followed while pursuing B.Pharm Course.

Details of the Resource Person/Event:

An Induction Program was conducted to welcome new B.Pharm and M.Pharm students for Academic year 2025-26. The event was chaired by Prof. Dr. Tushar Lokhande and was coordinated by Dr. Anuradha. V. Pai, Ms. Rashmi Ghuge and Mr. Prathmesh. K.

The Induction Program commenced with an introduction to Maharashtra Educational Society and the legacy of Late Prof. Javed Khan, followed by an address by the Principal, Dr. Tushar Lokhande, who outlined the institutional vision, mission, and the academic culture of H.K. College of Pharmacy. Faculty members from all departments were introduced, providing students an overview of the teaching structure and support system available to them.

Students received detailed guidance on essential academic policies, including the 75% mandatory attendance requirement, sessional examinations, internal assessment components, practical journal submissions, dress code, and campus conduct rules. The Examination Ordinance, Code of Conduct, and discipline-related guidelines were explained thoroughly to ensure smooth academic progression and professional behaviour.

A comprehensive overview of academic enrichment opportunities was provided, including the opportunity; to enroll in Value-Added Courses such as MITCON and the government based courses eg. SWAYAM/NPTEL, to engage in research and scientific activities, to participate in research competitions such as Aavishkar and CiiA, to be involved in community service initiatives, to visit industrial complexes, and to be a part of Student Council activities. Students were oriented towards platforms that enable them to cultivate research skills, innovation, leadership, teamwork, and holistic development.

A dedicated session on MAHA DBT Scholarships (Direct Benefit Transfer) educated students about eligibility criteria, required documents, income limits, Aadhaar–bank linking, and step-by-step procedures for successful application. This ensured that students from various categories could access financial support without difficulty.

The Induction Program successfully oriented new students to academic expectations, support systems, scholarship processes, and career growth opportunities, ensuring a smooth transition into professional pharmacy education.

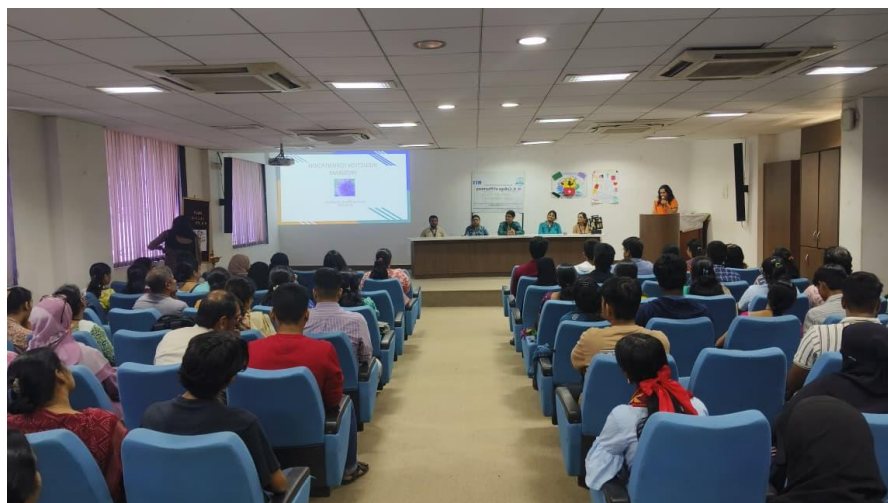

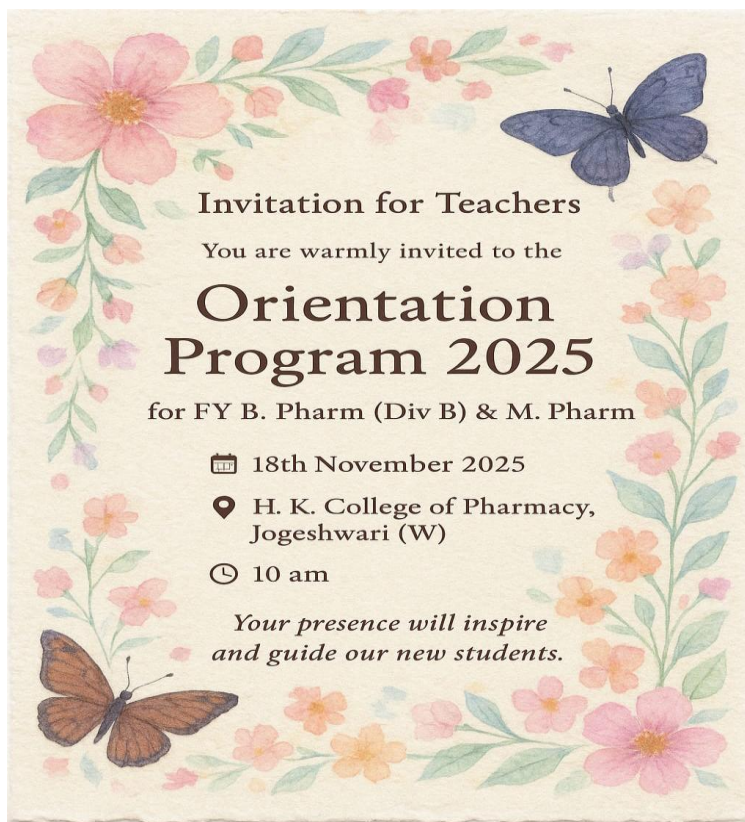

Summary of the Lecture/Activity:

- **Introduction to HKCP & MES** – Overview of the college's heritage, leadership, departments, faculty members, and institutional achievements.
- **Academic Framework Explained** – Attendance requirements (75%), sessional exams, internal assessment structure, practical journal rules, and examination guidelines.
- **Campus Conduct & Discipline Orientation** – ID card usage, dress code, lab etiquette, cleanliness (Swachh Bharat emphasis), submission deadlines, and responsible use of campus resources.
- **Scholarship Awareness Session (MAHA DBT)** – Step-by-step guidance on DBT schemes (EBC, Minority, OBC/SEBC/VJNT), income criteria, essential documents, and Aadhaar seeding requirements.
- **Introduction to Co-curricular & Extra-curricular Platforms** – Student Council, DLLE (with grace marks), sports, cultural events, intercollegiate competitions, scientific conferences, and community service programs.
- **Information on GPAT, Industrial Visits, Research Platforms** (Aavishkar, CiiA, Techcrunch), preparing students for higher studies and national-level competitiveness.
- **Feedback Mechanism** – Students were encouraged to share suggestions and reflect on their learning experience through a structured feedback form.

Key Outcome of the Lecture/Activity:

- **Students gained a comprehensive understanding of the college structure**, including the vision of Maharashtra Educational Society, the role of the Principal, and the academic and administrative framework of H.K. College of Pharmacy.
- **Clear orientation on academic expectations and discipline**—students understood attendance rules, examination ordinance, dress code, lab conduct, and code of behavior required for professional development.
- **Awareness of academic enrichment opportunities**, including Value Added Courses (such as MITCON, SWAYAM/NPTEL), scientific activities, Aavishkar, CiiA, GPAT preparation, industrial visits, and research-driven events.
- **Detailed guidance on scholarship processes (MAHA DBT)** equipped students with essential knowledge on eligibility, required documents, Aadhaar–bank linking, and deadlines to ensure smooth application.
- **Exposure to career-oriented modules (MITCON Series)** helped students understand clinical research careers, interpersonal skills, aptitude readiness, interview preparation, and selection strategies.
- **Strengthened student readiness and confidence** by introducing them to mentoring systems, student council, sports & cultural activities, DLLE opportunities, and college support services.
