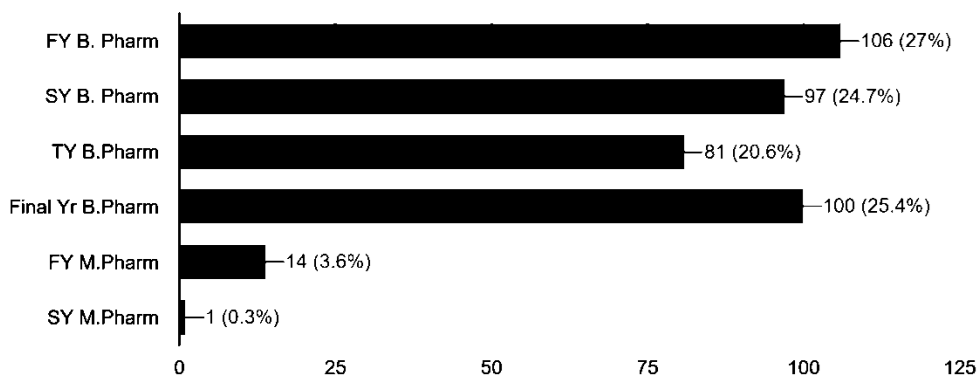

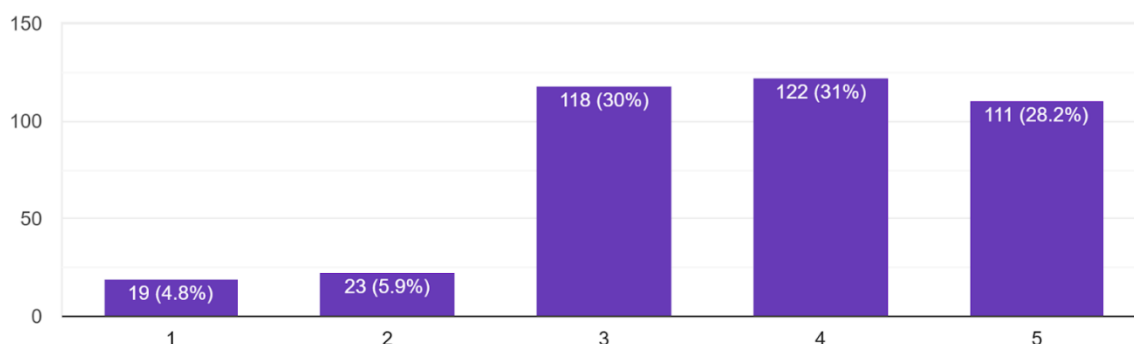

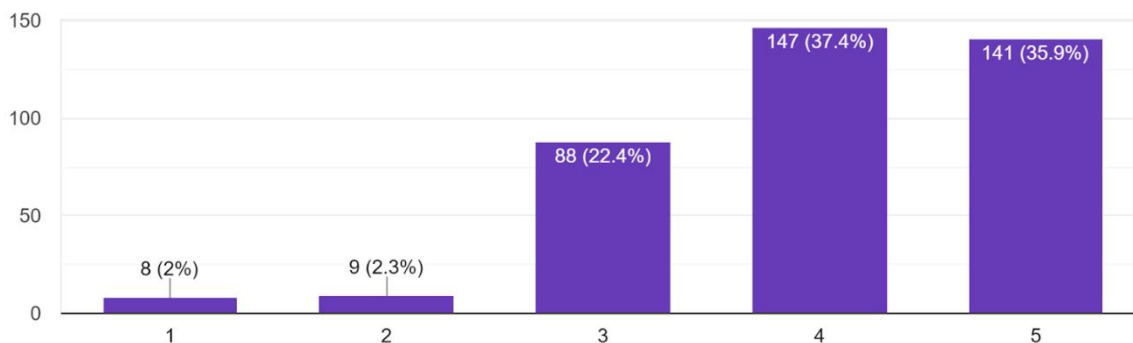
Standard of infrastructure and facility provided

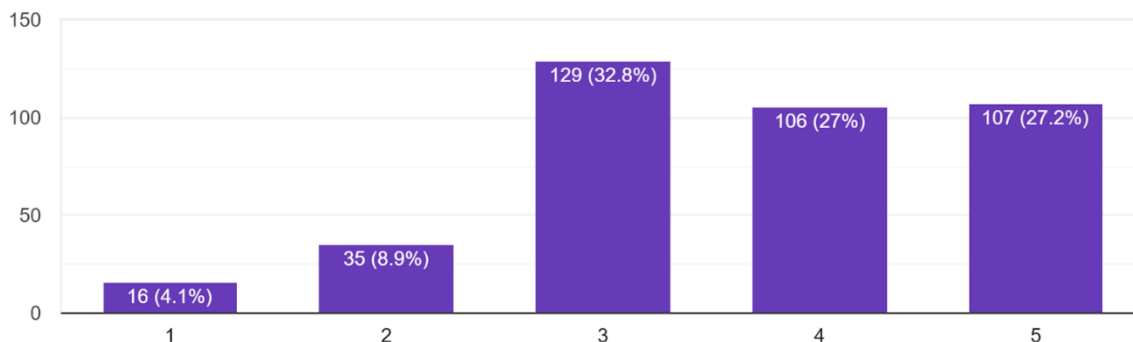
Awareness about medicine for effective and safe use

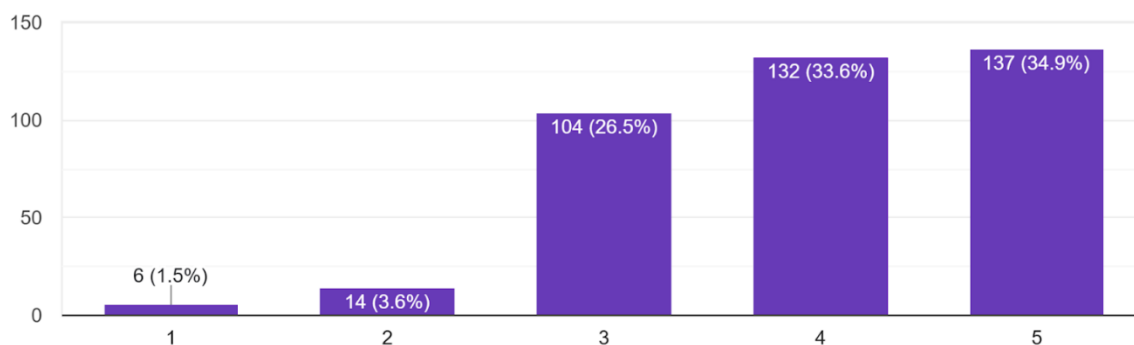

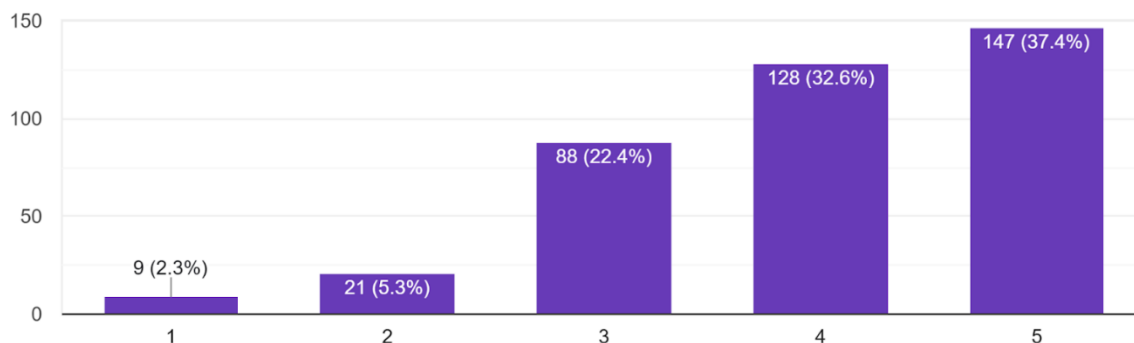
Motivation for higher studies

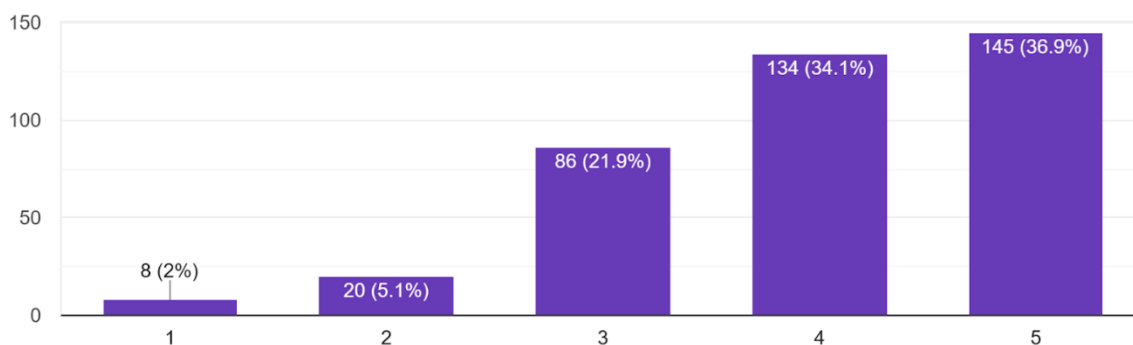
Involvement in social activities

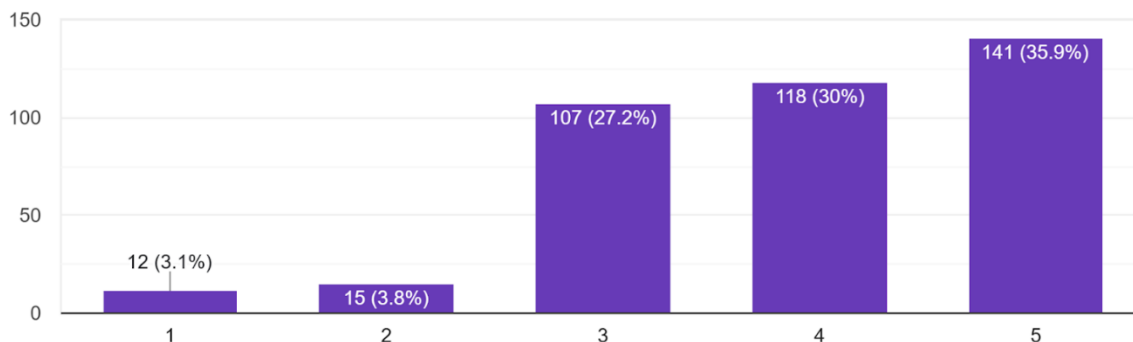
Expression of professional ethics
